Siegfried I would say this 64 page hardcover book does what you'd expect it to do. The book has abundant photos of types of antique metalwork and silver items handmade in the early 1900s. The introduction gives information about two men instrumental to the Arts Crafts movement: John Ruskin and William Morris. The movement was in response to the increasing industrialization (such as factory assembly lines) of the making of items for the home. Ruskin, Morris, and others believed machine-made items lowered the market and appreciation of those items handmade by artisans, which they also deemed to be of better quality and aesthetic value to the homeowner. The examples shown and described in the plentiful photos give those who want to research these items further online the vocabulary and artist names to do so. Some of the search terms which would prove useful to the beginning devotee to the Arts Crafts style are: Ruskin, Morris, Roycroft, Stickley, English Silver, Bookends, Liberty, Buffalo Bungalows, California Copper, and Red Warty Ware. The book is a nice little reference book on this subject to help increase your knowledge and visual recognition of these pieces and their time period.
